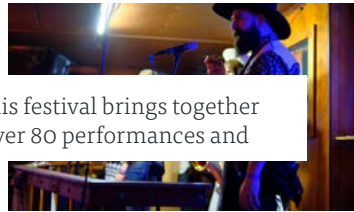
Prost! The CU Oktoberfest features locally-brewed beer and German imports, food by locally-owned restaurants, and authentic German music!

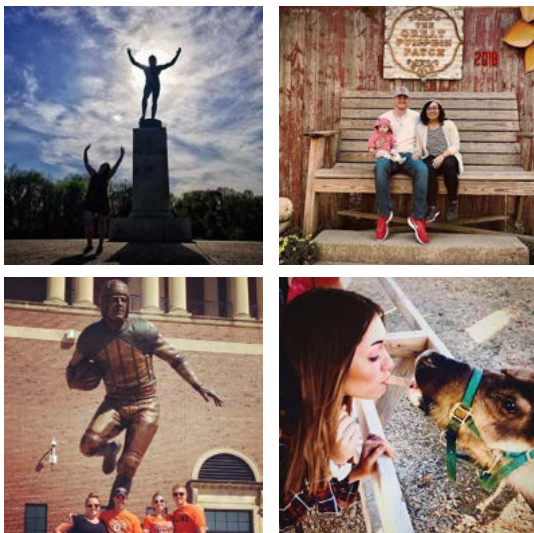
